The UK's COVID19 death toll, 60,113, is now the highest in Europe. Germany's "lockdown light" has proven inadequate to the task, and hospital ICUs are approaching capacity. France and Belgium have brought their second waves under control. India has seen fewer than 50,000 new cases every day for the past month. and fewer than 40,330


